LUX SANTA | SYNOPSIS

Crotone, small town in southern Italy, about 70 thousand inhabitants. Every 13 December on the silent background of the sky and the sea, groups of children honor the tradition of the fires of Saint Lucia building and burning majestic wooden pyramids.

Popular legend tells that Santa Lucia was blind.

The paintings portray her with a lost look in the void and in hand a silver plate with eyes. Therefore, the ritual, in the town, does not only derive from a banal tradition, instead has the intent to return through the fire light (lux) to Saint Lucia in his day.

To move the story will be the group of boys in the neighborhood "Fondo Gesù" that in their days, through the streets of the city to the search for wood, deal with their personal problems.

Children who at the age of 15 find themselves to live already without their fathers and are forced to be men, feeling the insurmountable weight of the loss of adolescence. There are those who deal with a father in prison, who has never known him or who, from here to shortly, will lose him.

A rite that of the Fires of Saint Lucia that unites them as brothers in pursuing a single objective: to achieve the the city's tallest and most imposing structure. The majestic Burning pyramid helps them find again, as well as youth lost, even the "lux" in their dark lives.

LUX SANTA | Director's note

The (neo)realistic matrix with which the themes are treated gives great importance to the socio-anthropological component, through which young people of Rione Fondo Gesù are shown and retracted in thesocial dynamics that support it. People are used rather than characters - or rather starting from the first to build the seconds. This cinema matrix of reality is often interrupted by a built language typical of films thus revealing a hybrid style.

Lux Santa has the intent to lift the veil from the black chronicle and show spirals of a beauty usually hidden. Document a millennial tradition that can withstand the years and raise it to a spiritual level. Our protagonists, through their eyes full of pain, lead us through the ways of show us how in such a hostile territory (Fondo Gesù), life, friendship and union around this tradition popular helps them survive the absence of their fathers.

The first goal I set myself is to shorten the distance, first, between me and my "new friends" and

bring the viewer closer to those lives, so that completely natural. Give the feeling to those who watch

be there with them to overcome every obstacle and to reach the summit of the majestic pyramid. Thus, shorten the distance between work and reality, between subject and object.

The narrative structure is merges with the documentary scenario of the film. Tradition and the myth of Saint Lucia are narrated through the deeds of teenagers of Rione Fondo Gesù. The wall between reality and but fiction is invisible, the documentary elements disappear every time the narrative structure (which tells the problems of our protagonists) takes over.

I had access to these lives entirely exclusively, won the trust of the dowel families, after dowel and

now I find myself having a second family- I felt obliged to bring their fragility, their strength, their dreams, their beauty.

MATTEO RUSSO | Director



Born in Crotone in 1992. In 2011 he met cinema at the Academy of Fine Arts in Bologna, founding a collective to shoot the first video clips. In 2014 on the set of the film "Confusi e felici" by Massimiliano Bruno, he plays the role of assistant director. After this first experience he produced and directed the first two personal film projects: "Voglia di fragola" written by Emilio Maria Costa and " Storia di una donna che amava suo figlio" slected in many national and international film festivals. Over the years he has directed various video clips and commercials such as the commercial for "Barilla" and the documentary on the singer Clementino. In 2018 he produced and directed: "Amal" and "Amare affondo" purchased by Rai Cinema in 2019. Just in this year, he studied at the NYFA in Los Angeles where he shot the short film "Tell Me Your Name" in Hollywood. In 2020 he founded the Calabria Movie International short film festival. He currently continues to collaborate with various Italian productions such as Italian International Film, Fabula pictures, 11 Marzo Film, Daitona, Naffintusi. In the last two years he has dedicated himself to his first feature documentary "Lux Santa" produced by Naffintusi with Rai Cinema.

In 2023 coproduces the short film "Eschaton AD" by Andrea Gatopoulos at the Locarno Festival in the Pardi di Domani section. Also in 2023 coproduces the short film "Las Memorias perdidas de los arboles" by Antonio La Camera who wins the award for Best Short Film at the Week of the Critics of the International Art Exhibition Cinema of Venice. Currently Naffintusi is engaged in the preproduction of the new film by director of Orazio Guarino "Let the flames burn" and in the theatrical release of the documentary by Matteo Russo "Lux Santa" produced in collaboration with Rai Cinema.
